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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with Section 113-5 of the Public Laws of St Mary's County, the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission (MetCom) will hold a Public Hearing to discuss the **FDR Boulevard Phase 1B Water Main Project No. 8151WM**. The project includes infrastructure improvements in coordination with the Department of Public Works and Transportation's FDR Boulevard Extended (Neighborhood Connector) Phase 1 Roadway Project. This project will include a water distribution system loop between the First Colony and Laurel Glen service areas. This water main loop will improve system reliability and maximize distribution efficiency of adjacent wells and storage facilities.

The project includes installing new water mains and constructing connections to existing water lines along the new alignment of FDR Boulevard, from the existing water lines on First Colony Boulevard to Old Rolling Road and from existing water lines on Monterey Lane to Barefoot Drive. The work consists of installation of approximately 3,450 linear feet of new 12" water line, and includes new fire hydrants, water services, and associated appurtenances and restoration. The estimated total cost for this project is \$1,509,300.

The Public Hearing will be held on Wednesday, August 26, 2015, beginning at 6:30 PM at the Commission's offices, 23121 Camden Way, California, MD. The proposed contract documents, which include plans and specifications, can be inspected at the time of the hearing or at MetCom's Engineering Department office location, noted above, from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday through Friday.
