The Hearing will be held to discuss the proposed Fiscal Year 2018 Capital Improvement Budget, the proposed Fiscal Years 2019-2023 Capital Improvement Plan and the proposed Fiscal Year 2018 Operating Budget and proposed rate changes relating to each budget, to become effective July 1, 2017.
